## Daily Update on COVID-19

As new information continues to emerge about the COVID-19 Coronavirus, the Township of Bloomfield wants to make sure all residents are well informed on the steps we are taking to keep everyone safe.

- The Township Council Meeting will be live stream and broadcasted on Channel 35, (Comcast), Channel 30 (Verizon), YouTube and Facebook Live. Please check our township website for these links on Monday.
- The Municipal Court will hold a few calendar cases on Monday, March 16<sup>th</sup>, but will then close until March 23<sup>rd</sup>. All cases that were scheduled after March 16<sup>th</sup> will be adjourned for a later date and a new court notice will be mailed.
- The Library will be closed as of 5:00 pm Friday, March 13<sup>th</sup> with a tentative reopen date of April 1<sup>st</sup>. Please visit the library website and Facebook for additional information.
- Schools will be closed for 2 weeks starting Monday. Attached is the letter from the Superintendent.
