

We are pleased to announce that Bloomfield's Neighbor to Neighbor Network (NTNN) has just been granted 501(c) (3) status as a public charity by the Internal Revenue Service. Why is this great news? Because it means that any contributions, transfers, gifts, devises, and bequests that are made to the NTNN are tax deductible.

Why should you contribute to the Neighbor to Neighbor Network? Through the NTNN, Human Services collaborates with community organizations, local citizens and businesses to recruit volunteers who provide resident services not available through traditional programs. After the division conducts a home-based assessment, volunteers are matched with residents in need to provide services such as minor home repair and maintenance, shopping, tutoring, visitation and transportation. NTNN also serves people whose lives are unexpectedly disrupted by hardship. The Network fills immediate gaps and then finds ways to bring long-term resolution.
