2024 ORDINANCE AMENDMENT

AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE CHAPTER 491, "SOLID WASTE" ARTICLE IV "Containerized Yard Waste" § 491-19 Prohibited conduct WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BLOOMFIELD

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Township of Bloomfield, County of Essex, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 491 "Solid Waste," ARTICLE IV "Containerized Yard Waste" § 491-19 Prohibited conduct in the Code of the Township of Bloomfield, County of Essex, State of New Jersey, is hereby amending the following section to read as follows:

§ 491-19 Prohibited conduct.
B. Biodegradable bag collection.

- (1) The Township regulations require that brush, branches, yard raking and other vegetative matter be placed in biodegradable bags only for collection by the Township. Pickups will be made on the same day as recycling pickups.
- (2) Leaves shall be placed in biodegradable bags only for curbside pickup by the Township during the periods of:
 - a. March 15th through May 15th
 - b. October 15th through December 31st
 - c. No bags containing leaves shall be picked up outside of those periods
- (3) Christmas trees will be picked up beginning on January 1st and will end on January 31st. No Christmas trees shall be placed at curbside outside of this period. Christmas trees placed at curbs will not be picked up unless all decorations, ornaments, lights, tinsel, etc., are completely removed.
- (4) Grass clippings will be picked up beginning May 1st and will end on October 31st. Grass clippings bags will be limited to 3 bags per pick up per household. Additional bags will be the homeowner's responsibility to remove from the curbside within 24 hours of the pickup day.
- (5) Leaves and grass clippings shall be placed into separate biodegradable bags and shall not be comingled.


(6) Soft vegetative waste collection will resume in the spring.

Section 2. All ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This amendment shall take effect upon final passage and publication in accordance with the law.


