Mental Health Services



According to the U.S Department of Health and Human Services, One in five American adults experienced a mental health issue (2011). Mental health problems are very common but help is readily available.

- Counseling: Residents can make appointments for individual, couple, family, group or child/adolescent counseling.
- Psychiatric Services: Psychiatric assessment, medication monitoring, and consultation is available for those receiving counseling services at Bloomfield Human Services.
- Crisis Intervention: Individuals experiencing feelings of depression, anxiety, suicide or confusion can reach out to a trained professional for individual or family counseling.
- Education/Prevention: Community mental health is a high priority and programs are tailored to specific needs.
