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STEP 1: CHECK IF YOU ARE ALREADY A REGISTERED VOTER

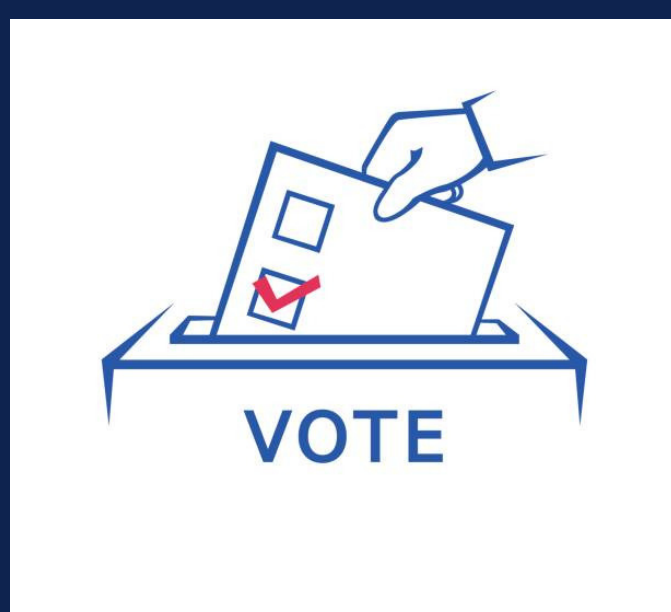

STEP 2: SEE IF YOU ARE ELIGIBLE TO BE A VOTER

If you qualify under the following, you can move on to Step 3:

- ✓ A United States citizen
- ✓ At least 18 years old at the time of the election (November 3)
- ✓ A resident of your county for at least 30 days before the election
- ✓ A person NOT serving a sentence of incarceration at the current time





STEP 3: FILE TO BECOME A REGISTERED VOTER

The New Jersey voter registration deadline for the November 2020 election is

October 13, 2020

Two Options:

1. Register to vote online
2. Register to vote by mail

STEP 4: FILE TO BECOME A REGISTERED VOTER ONLINE

- Use the following link to register to vote online and click "Online Voter Registration Now Available!"

- You will need:
 - A current and valid Driver's License or a non-driver Identification Card (ID card) issued by the New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission (MVC)
 - OR a Social Security Number
- Fill out the registration according to the directions, and you will be registered to vote!



STEP 5: FILE TO BECOME A REGISTERED VOTER BY MAIL

- If you prefer to register to vote by mail (you should only register through one format: online or by mail):
- Use the following link to access your voter registration files based on the county where you reside:

Registering to vote for the first time means that you will have to provide an ID Proof

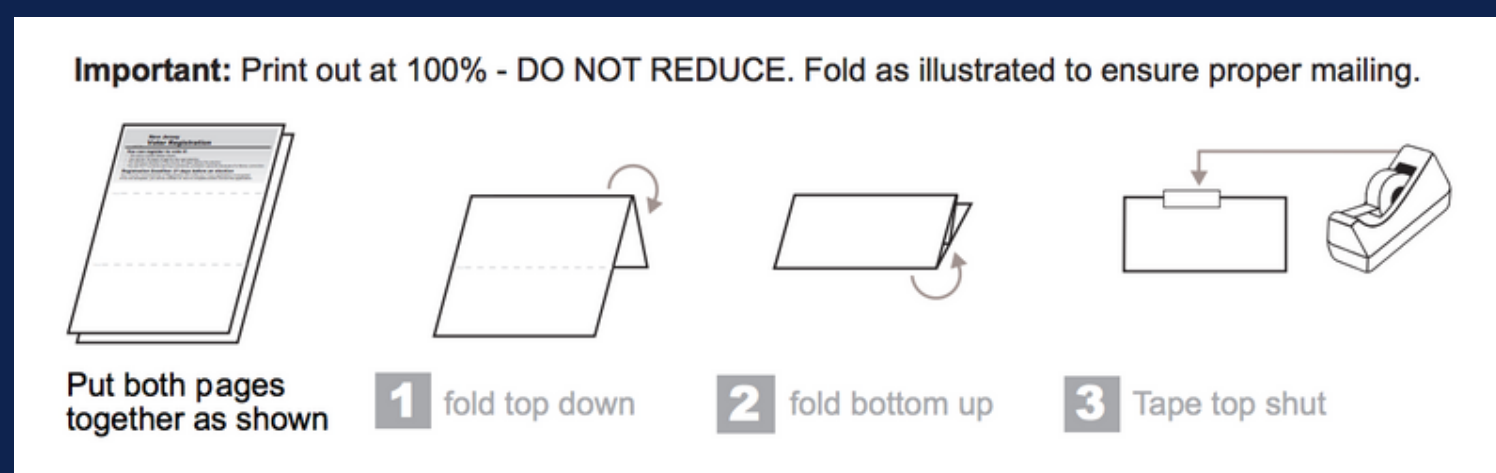

If you use the website <https://www.state.nj.us/state/elections/voter-registration.shtml>, the form will already have your county's mail in address written on it, and you are done and ready to mail it.
